1. National level

3. community level

The IYCP project will be managed under the VRCS Disaster Risk Management department, In partnership with the Ministry of Education and the provincial Education, Teachers in each targeted schools also these project will make sure to have the support of the community level.

The project will support an officer and support officers at each branch level for the first 18 Month, the project will need support officers in Amebae and Malekula on the first phase and three support officers at Tana , Santo and Sola, to Help with Monitoring and Evaluation of the project and making sure that the project will be executed as planned.
