SUBJECT: Lui Bell Memorial Scholarship Fund – Call for Applications

Dear SPREP Focal Points,

The Secretariat is now inviting applications for the Lui Bell Memorial Scholarship, which has been established to honour the life and work of Lui Bell and his commitment to the conservation of marine species in the Pacific Islands. The scholarship is designed to support the delivery of the SPREP 2013 - 2017 Marine Species Action Plan¹ (MSAP) and aims to develop the expertise of Pacific Island nationals in areas related to the conservation and management of dugongs, marine turtles, sharks and cetaceans.

The scholarship is open to Pacific island students from SPREP Pacific Island member countries² to obtain postgraduate qualifications in the disciplines of marine biology, environmental science, marine science, climate change and environmental law or such other disciplines as may be relevant. Applicants must be under 40 years of age, and willing to undertake full time post-graduate studies in marine species conservation at a recognized institution.

Further details of the Scholarship and an Application Form are attached. Nominations will close on 31 May, 2014 and a decision on the successful applicant or applicants will be made in June.
