

#### Introduction

This report is a compilation and assessment of organizational capacities for disaster risk, climate change and sustainable development matters in Vanuatu.

This report is based on a social network analysis that was conducted in Vanuatu during three months in 2014 in order to understand the patterns of communication and collaboration for disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation. This study revealed a general certain lack of awareness concerning who has which capacity in and outside of the country. It also revealed capacities of 260 stakholders that have experience in Vanuatu and open high potential of collaboration. The author developed a methodology to help capitalising these capacities and offering a tool to easily know in which organisation staff with useful capacities work and where information could be found.

This report gathers individual capacities of 260 stakeholders in and outside of Vanuatu, who have experience and/or a link with the country, and thus, are potential collaborators for any future project. However, in a matter of anonymity and in order to avoid outdating of information with staff turn-over, names are not given, only organizations, where the stakeholders work, are listed.

In this report can be found useful information to answer to the following questions:

- I need someone with capacities that would help me to develop and implement a project, which organization should I approach?
- I need information on what is happening in Vanuatu, in the region or in the world within a certain sector (such as climate change adaptation, agriculture or gender), which organization would have such information?
  - I have questions on a certain sector or concept; I wonder if someone has an answer?
  - I would like to get capacities in a certain sector which organization could help me?

Three measures are considered thougout this report:

- 1. The in-degree: called "connection level" in this report. The in-degree measures how many people named the stakeholder as capacity holder.
- 2. The betweeness: called "information access" in this report. The betweeness measures the power the stakeholder has on information flow within the network by being on the path of the most direct link between other stakeholders.
- 3. The eigenvector: called "influence ability" in this report. The eigenvector measures the position of influence potential in the whole network by being connected to highly central members of the network. By being connected to highly central people, the stakeholder is potentially having lots of influence on all the indirectly linked members of the network.

The tools are organised by sectors:

#### For each sector:

- Three positions within the whole network are categorised:
  - the centrality of the stakeholder
  - stakeholders who have the most direct acces to information
  - stakeholders who have a critical influencial position because they are linked with highly central stakeholders
- Seven types of capacities are categorised:
  - Capacity building
  - Technical support
  - Implementation support
  - Political support/endorsement/approval
  - Funding support
  - Networking and linking stakeholders
  - Informal Advice

It is very important to understand that the listing does not mean that some stakeholders are more capable than others, but that more participants of the study ask them for help.

Also, this report represents only 260 stakeholders, it is far from being comprehensive of capacities that exist in Vanuatu.

Further data collection needs to be done in all provinces in order to add provincial and community capacities to these results, which are mainly gathering individuals from Shefa Province.

This report aims to give a starting idea of how to organise and capitalise capacities repartition in Vanuatu. Updating of information in this report should be constant.
